Trade of the day was for the older cows with many making in the high teens of hundreds even having had five or more lactations. The day saw 19 milkers make over £2000 with the top price of £2470 for a fresh Monty second calver. She sold to Messrs Brakewell, Cumbria who were the volume buyers of the day. Cattle travelled back to new homes as far a field as Pembroke, Leicester, Ayrshire, Devon & Cheshire.
