WHINCHAT FINAL CHAPTER

The final dispersal sale of the Birkle family's noted Whinchat herd which took place on farm in Leicestershire attracted purchasers from Scotland to Cornwall and all points in between, drawn by the exceptional quality of the cattle on offer in terms of both their conformation and their wonderfully deep pedigrees. Andrew Birkle has bred quality Holsteins for more than 40 years and assembled some outstanding female families acquired through astute purchases in this country and the importation of embryos from the USA. Three previous sales from the herd have been held since 2000 and the herd's reputation drew both old and new customers for this final chapter.

Top price was 8,800gs paid by Blaise Tomlinson for an outstanding 12th generation Excellent third calver by Doorman from the noted Savoire Fare family which has been a signature line in the Whinchat herd for many years and is descended from embryos originally purchased from the famous Pinehurst herd in the States. Her heifer calf by Stantons Right Stuff made 3,800gs to the Pyne family's Postlake herd in Devon and Lancashire breeder Tom Riley acquired her Stantons Adorable in calf heifer for 5,100gs.

Blaise was a keen contender for many of the best cattle on offer, purchasing cows from the Flo and Star families for 7,200 and 6,000gs and adding more than 30 animals in all to his Sandyford herd in the county, many of them at over 3,000gs,

Another Savoire Fare to catch much attention was a second calf Unix daughter, sold for 7,500gs to join the Tregibby herd of Hefin Wilson, Cardigan, who has few superiors in purchasing quality animals, Her daughters made 3,600 and 3,200gs, both to Welsh breeders,

The Star family was one of the herd's best and most consistent families and three members of the family were among the top prices with Emma Murray, Shropshire giving 7,000gs for a VG-88 Tropic second calver; Bev Baker taking a VG 2yr by Adorable for 6,100gs for the BB herd in Monmouthshire and Peter Waring acquiring a 95 point fifth calver for the Winton herd at 6,000gs,

There were a number of big volume buyers with Obsidian Holsteins Ltd taking 37 cows and served heifers for a new herd being established in Staffordshire; John Colgrove buying 16 milkers to go to Cornwall and Martin Evans Farming Ltd purchasing over 40 served and maiden heifers for their extensive enterprise on the Welsh border. The biggest volume buyers were Messrs Roberts who bought 55 heifer calves for their increasing herd near Ruthin in North Wales.

The whole sale which lasted over 9 hours returned the impressive average of £2,328 for the 559 animals sold of which nearly 200 were under a year old. We would like to thank Andrew and Mimi Birkle and their family for their consistent support over many years and wish them the best of luck for the future.
