SPARKLING TRADE AT THE 2023 WILLSBRO SALE

Holstein breders from throughout the UK and Southern Ireland descended on Messrs Wills Brothers' Cornish farm for a sale and open day, celebrating the work and memory of Anthony Wills, who sadly passed away a year ago. Many were present the day before the sale to view the impressive facilities at Pawton Dairy, where 1,700 cows presently average over 14,400kg at 4.06% fat and 3.24% protein Visitors could not fail to be impressed with the quality of the cattle, which recently won this year's Holstein UK Premier Herd Competition.

On sale day there was a frenetic trade throughout, fuelled by high genomic figures and classification scores, when 100 milking cows and heifers and 250 heifers and calves went under the hammer in nearly 9 hours of trading with demand remaining right to the end of the sale, resulting in a total close on a million pounds.

It was towards the end of the sale that the top price was achieved when after a firce bidding duel, Bryan and John O'Connor of the Bawnmore herd in Co.Cork secured the 10 month old Willsbro Lambda Baywatch 4536 ET for 14.500gs. She is a granddaughter of the World Dairy Expo Champion Rosiers Blexy Goldwyn (Ex-97) and her dam has several prizewinning sisters, both in the UK and across the Atlantic.

Top priced cow was another Lambda, a VG-87 pointed heifer from the Roxy family, bred from 10 generations of this popular family and descended from one of Anthony Wills's most notable purchases, Stardale Leader Roxy (Ex-95), that has produced a wonderful legacy in the Willsbro herd. Malcolm McLean, bidding on Marteye, paid 13,000gs to take her back to the Relough herd, Co Tyrone and he later purchased another outstanding Lambda daughter from the Pammy family for 9,500gs. Lambda daughters were in particular demand and the O'Connors went to 9,500gs for one of the first heifers sold over here from the outstanding European Galys-Vray family.

Willsbro Perennial Elaya 4320 ET is the current No 1 PTAT female in the world and made 12,000gs to Mike Potter, bidding on behalf of a syndicate and the highest PLI calf in the Sale at over £800, a Cookiecutter Holysmokes daughter from the Lila Z family made 7,400gs to Messrs Crummy, Co Roscommon in the Republic of Ireland.

More than 50 animals made 4,000gs or more and over 130 individual buyers were recorded. There were still plenty of bargains among the lower prices and plenty of breeders will have secured valuable animals for the future of their own herds at reasonable figures.

The atmosphere throughout the two days was excellent, with entertainment provided on Friday night at the Royal Cornwall Showground by a local band singing sea shanties, followed by an interesting talk by leading American breeder Jordan Siemers. On sale day the Wills family members and their helpers kept everyone supplied with an array of Cornish produce and no one would have left the farm hungry or thirsty.

It was certainly a sale to remember from what must now be regarded as one of the world's foremost dairy units and the Willsbro herd will continue to strive to go ever onwards and upwards. Anthony's children Robert, Mathew and Melanie are perpetuating their father's legacy and put on a great show for all those fortunate to attend.
